- We will never use AI at the expense of artists of any kind and recognize that AI-generated content is not a replacement for human creativity or artistic practice.
- We strictly adhere to copyright laws and respect the rights of creators. We will use our voice to advocate for policies and practices that ensure artists and creators are fairly recognized and compensated for the use of their work.
- We believe in the potential of AI, if developed and used responsibly, to provide intelligent automation without dehumanization and without replacing or encroaching on artists and their essential role in society.
- AI technologies will assist, not replace, human creativity, judgment, and decision-making. Staff remain accountable for all decisions and actions.
- We believe digital tools, including AI, can help the arts improve efficiency and reduce administrative burden.
- We use AI to assist in articulating the positive impact of our funding programs, iterating our training and learning programs, supporting our research, and telling stories with and about the arts community. We do not use AI for any decision-making around funding or training application adjudication.
- We believe in the importance of helping arts professionals build the knowledge and confidence to make informed decisions about AI whether they choose to use it often, selectively, or not at all.
- We centre integrity, honesty, and transparency in all AI applications. We comply with applicable privacy and data protection laws and strive to protect confidential information while using AI responsibly.
- We recognize the limitations and risks of AI and commit to continually improving our understanding and practices as the technology evolves, and evolving our commitments.
- We support the responsible use of AI to improve accessibility and inclusion through tools such as captioning, transcription, translation, and plain-language adaptations.
- We are open to partnerships with organizations and individuals that align with our values, and we aim to share our experiences, research, learning, and knowledge about AI with the wider arts community.
- We believe responsible AI is a shared responsibility. We expect employees, consultants, contractors, volunteers, and service providers undertaking work on behalf of Rozsa Foundation to understand and uphold these commitments whenever AI is used in the course of their work.
- Our Responsible AI Commitments reflect our dedication to ethical conduct, social responsibility, and positive impact. As AI continues to evolve, we remain steadfast in our commitment to artists, our mission, and the communities we serve, ensuring that technology serves people—not the other way around.
